NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE TO H.R. 5
OFFERED BY M . _____**

Page 97, line 23, strike the period at the end and the closed quotation marks.

Page 97, after line 23, insert the following:

1 “(g) FUNDING.—There are appropriated to carry out
2 this section, in addition to any other amounts appro-
3 priated to carry out this section, \$2,083,333,333.33 for
4 each of the fiscal years 2016 through 2021.”.

Page 105, line 24, strike “section” and insert “sections”.

Page 106, line 20, strike the period at the end and the closed quotation marks.

Page 106, after line 20, insert the following:

5 “(f) FUNDING.—There are appropriated to carry out
6 this section, in addition to any other amounts appro-
7 priated to carry out this section, \$2,083,333,333.33 for
8 each of the fiscal years 2016 through 2021.”.

In section 604 of the Amendment—

(1) in the section heading, strike “**AMEND-
MENT**” and insert “**AMENDMENTS**”;

(2) strike “Section” and insert the following:

3 (b) SECTION 611.—Section 611 of the Individuals
4 with Disabilities Education Act (20 U.S.C. 1411) is
5 amended by adding at the end the following:

8 priated to carry out this section, \$2,083,333,333.33 for
9 each of the fiscal years 2016 through 2021.”.

Add at the end of the Amendment the following:

10 **SEC. 802. FUNDING FOR PRESCHOOL EDUCATION.**

11 The following sums are appropriated to the Secretary
12 of Education to make grants to States to implement high-
13 quality prekindergarten programs as part of the establish-
14 ment of Federal-State partnerships to provide access to
15 high-quality public prekindergarten programs for all chil-
16 dren from low-income and moderate-income families to en-
17 sure that they enter kindergarten prepared for success:

18 (1) \$1,300,000,000 for fiscal year 2016.

19 (2) \$3,250,000,000 for fiscal year 2017.

1 (3) \$5,112,500,000 for each of the fiscal years
2 2018 through 2021.

3 **SEC. 803. PAY-GO NOT APPLICABLE.**

4 (1) STATUTORY PAY-AS-YOU GO SCORECARDS.—
5 The budgetary effects of sections 1125(g) and
6 1125A(f) of the Elementary and Secondary Edu-
7 cation Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C. 6335; 6337), and sec-
8 tion 611(j) of the Individuals with Disabilities Edu-
9 cation Act (20 U.S.C. 1411), as amended by this
10 Act, and section 802 of this Act shall not be entered
11 on either PAYGO score-card maintained pursuant to
12 section 4(d) of the Statutory Pay-As-You-Go Act of
13 2010.

14 (2) SENATE PAYGO SCORECARDS.—The budg-
15 etary effects of the sections described in paragraph
16 (1) shall not be entered on any PAYGO scorecard
17 maintained for purposes of section 201 of S. Con.
18 Res. 21 (110th Congress).
