RESTRICTIONS ON LOBBYING AND POLITICAL 2 **ACTIVITIES.** 3 "(a) Lobbying Restrictions.— 4 "(1) Publicity restrictions.— 5 "(A) In General.—Subject to subpara-6 graph (B), no funds provided under this Act 7 shall be used or proposed for use, for— "(i) publicity or propaganda purposes; 8 9 or 10 "(ii) the preparation, distribution, or 11 use of any kit, pamphlet, booklet, publica-12 tion, electronic communication, radio, tele-13 vision, or video presentation designed to 14 support or defeat the enactment of legisla-15 tion before the Congress or any State or

local legislature or legislative body.
