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1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

2 This Act may be cited as the "Protecting Health Care3 Providers from Increased Administrative Burdens Act".

4 SEC. 2. NON-FEDERAL CONTRACTOR STATUS FOR ENTITIES 5 RECEIVING CERTAIN HEALTH CARE-RE6 LATED FEDERAL PAYMENTS.

7 A State, a local government, or other recipient that 8 receives a payment from the Federal Government, directly 9 or indirectly and regardless of reimbursement methodology, related to the delivery of health care services to indi-10 viduals, whether or not such individuals are or have been 11 12 employed by the Federal Government, shall not be treated as a Federal contractor or subcontractor by the Office of 13 Federal Contract Compliance Programs based on the work 14 performed or actions taken by such individuals that re-15 sulted in the receipt of such payments. 16
