

**AMENDMENT TO THE AMENDMENT IN THE
NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE TO H.R. 5003
OFFERED BY M R. SCOTT**

After paragraph (1) of section 106, insert the following (and redesignate the succeeding paragraphs accordingly):

1 (2) in subsection (b), by striking paragraph (2)
2 and inserting the following:

3 “(2) Any service institution may only serve
4 lunch and either breakfast or a meal supplement
5 during each day of operation, except that—

6 “(A) any service institution that is a camp
7 or that serves meals primarily to migrant chil-
8 dren may serve up to 3 meals, or 2 meals and
9 1 supplement, during each day of operation,
10 if—

11 “(i) the service institution has the ad-
12 ministrative capability and the food prepa-
13 ration and food holding capabilities (where
14 applicable) to serve more than one meal
15 per day, and

16 “(ii) the service period of different
17 meals does not coincide or overlap; and

1 “(B) any service institution that is not a
2 camp or that does not serve meals primarily to
3 migrant children may serve up to 3 meals, or
4 2 meals and 1 supplement, during each day of
5 operation, if—

6 “(i) the service institution is located
7 in one of the 10 States selected by the Sec-
8 retary in which such service institutions
9 may serve up to 3 meals, or 2 meals and
10 1 supplement, during each day of oper-
11 ation; and

12 “(ii) the service institution meets the
13 requirements of clauses (i) and (ii) of sub-
14 paragraph (A).”;
