THE PROBLEM

The Biden Administration's Title IX Rule is Hurting Women and Girls

- In April, the Biden administration announced its final Title IX rule that would erase vital protections for women and girls.
- This final rule removes female-only spaces such as locker rooms, bathrooms, and other sex-separated areas while also allowing biological males to compete within women's sports and organizations.
- The rule also undermines existing due process rights and places both students and institutions in legal jeopardy—further dismantling protections provided by Title IX.
- Biden's Title IX rule threatens to expunge decades of progress for women and girls across America.

THE SOLUTION

- Rep. Miller's *Congressional Review Act* resolution would stop the administration's final Title IX rule so that educational institutions can continue protecting the safety of women and girls and their access to educational opportunities.
- The administration claims that this final rule promotes both "educational equity" and "fairness," but all it does is leave women and girls vulnerable to all manner of threats.
- This rule will chill the free speech rights of students and educators who don't accept the Left's radical gender ideology.
- Women and girls would be subjected to an uneven playing field in athletics—a direct conflict with athletics' core principles of both integrity and fairness.

BOTTOM LINE: Republicans are taking a stand to stop President Biden's crusade against biological reality that is hurting women and girls.
