8	(1) in clause (iv), by redesignating subclauses
9	(I) through (III) as items (aa) through (cc), respec-
10	tively;
11	(2) by redesignating clauses (i) through (vii) as
12	subclauses (I) through (VII), respectively;
13	(3) in the matter preceding subclause (I), as so
14	redesignated, by striking "The term" and inserting
15	the following:
16	"(i) IN GENERAL.—The term"; and
17	(4) by adding at the end the following:

"(ii) Notification required.—
Within a reasonable timeframe prior to the
first convening of the individualized edu-
cation program team for a child with a dis-
ability for a school year, the local edu-
cational agency that serves such child shall
notify the parent of such child that such
parent may, under clause (i)(VI), include
other individuals who have knowledge or
special expertise regarding the child, in-
cluding related services personnel as appro-
priate, as part of the individualized edu-
cation program team.".
