

**AMENDMENT TO THE AMENDMENT IN THE
NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE TO H.R. 4843
OFFERED BY MR. POLIS OF COLORADO**

Page 2, after line 20, insert the following section
(and redesignate the subsequent sections accordingly):

1 **SEC. 4. TEMPORARY AUTHORITY REGARDING EDUCATION**
2 **ON PREVENTING UNAUTHORIZED ACCESS OF**
3 **CHILDREN TO OPIOID MEDICATIONS**
4 **PRESENT IN THE HOME.**

5 Section 106(b) of the Child Abuse Prevention and
6 Treatment Act (42 U.S.C. 5106a(b)) is amended by add-
7 ing at the end the following:

8 “(5) TEMPORARY AUTHORITY REGARDING EDU-
9 CATION ON PREVENTING UNAUTHORIZED ACCESS OF
10 CHILDREN TO OPIOID MEDICATIONS PRESENT IN
11 THE HOME.—For fiscal years 2017 through 2021, a
12 State plan under paragraph (1) may provide for
13 demonstration programs through which the child
14 protective services system, in consultation with sub-
15 stance abuse prevention programs, provides edu-
16 cation on the risks that children may gain unauthor-
17 ized access to opioid medications that have been pre-
18 scribed for their parents or guardians and are

1 present in the home, including education on pre-
2 venting unauthorized access through dispensing
3 opioid medications in prescription vials using new
4 technologies designed to permit only the intended
5 patient to have access.”.
